We have received this message through the Bracknell Christian Network. Local churches are supporting VSI Razom a local organisation that supports Ukrainian Refugees in Bracknell.

They are preparing to send another lorry to central Ukraine in the next week with essential items medical supplies, non-perishable items of food etc. The lorry is only half full and they really need more support.

#### Thanks from the Pines School

The money was spent on food vouchers and on food hampers, this supported 19 families. They also bought three blankets for a family and two Christmas presents for other families. Overall, it supported 22 families in our school.
